

Our classroom rules

Our school, Shanklea Primary, has created this agreement so that all pupils know how to behave when they are in class and around the school. We have amended our rules in accordance with Covid-19 guidelines and our amended behaviour policy. This will make sure our whole class is happy and we can get on with our work. Please read the rules to make sure you understand them - we want to make sure our school is a safe and happy learning environment!

I will:

- Follow social distancing expectations by remaining in own area
- Put my hand up when I want to say something.
- Listen to others when they are talking.
- Be respectful of others - my teachers and my class mates.
- Treat others as I would like to be treated.
- Be respectful of the environment and not damage any school property.
- Do as the teacher asks me and follow instructions.
- Complete all tasks I have been set and try my best with my work.
- Stop what I'm doing when my teacher asks me to.
- Take responsibility for my own behaviour.
- Tell the teacher if I feel frustrated, anxious or distracted.

I understand that if I don't follow the rules there may be consequences:

Step 1 - I will be reminded about my behaviour by the teacher

Step 2 - A 2nd behaviour reminder will be given and I will move to amber on the traffic light system.

Step 3 - I will move to red and then be given time to reflect on my behaviour. The incident will be recorded and my teacher will inform my parents.


Step 4 - If I have repeated episodes where I am moved to red, the behaviour will be discussed with a senior member of staff and my parents/carers will be contacted by my teacher to discuss ways to improve my behaviour. A behaviour contract may be set up with targets set in agreement with parents/carers and my teacher.

Step 5 - I will work in isolation as agreed by Mrs Brown.

Step 6 - Fixed term or permanent exclusion.
