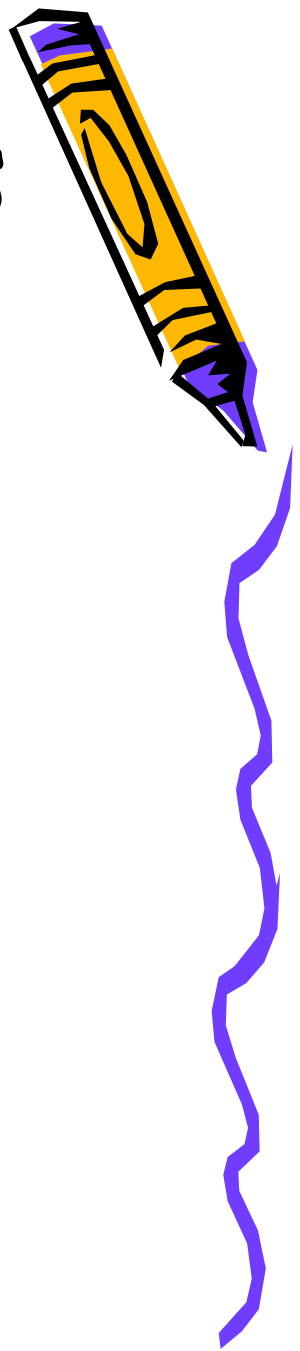


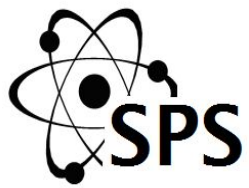
Typical school day

- 3:00 - 3:30 - Story and ready for home time

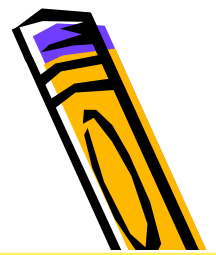

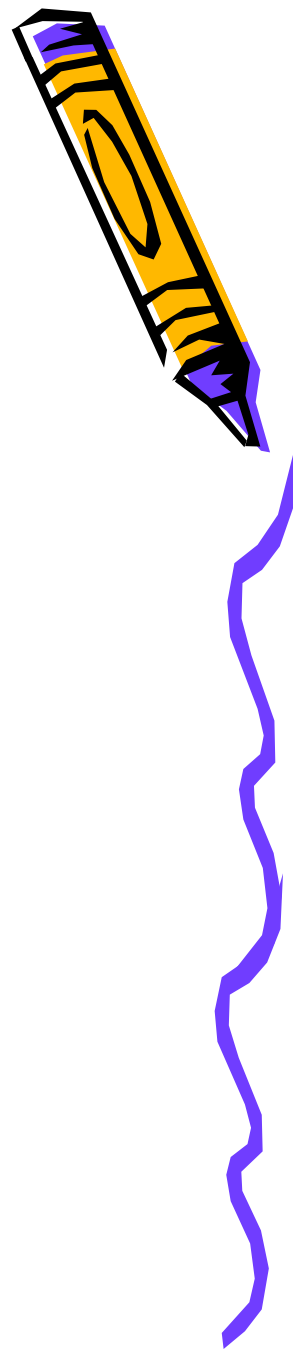
SPS If Problems arise...

- Head Teacher Mrs Ritson available each morning on the yard or by appointment if needed.





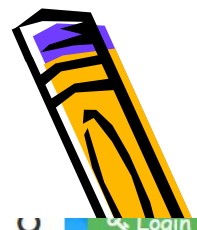
